Relay for Life: Connie lead this effort on 7/9 at the Monte Vista High School track from 6pm to 6am. Thirteen club ladies walked. The team took in \$1,000.00+ over and above the club's generous donation. The total raised in the valley was \$49,000.00. Team members were thanked for their effort.

Club Meetings: The August meeting will be held at the Masonic Park Pavilion, after which we return to the community building. Gail will no longer be handling pot luck supplies as she is facing back surgery. Volunteer(s) are needed.

Grooming: Bill has submitted the grant request to perform \$37,000.00 worth of grooming services this winter. Ronnie Day has been very helpful in this endeavor, also getting new permits and maps.

Hiking: Dennis reports hikes are held on Mondays (lead by Doug and leaving at 9:00 from visitor's center.) and on Tuesdays (lead by Dennis and leaving at 8:00 from Rickles Park) Dennis took over 40 GPS readings on Lake Fork Trail concerning needed repairs and plans to have a sign put up to give credit to the club. There will be the annual moonlight hike Friday 7/23 at Shaw Lake.

ATV Rides: Chuck reports 26 machines went to Boot Mountain last week. A good time was had by all, especially on those "extra" 10-12 miles. Yesterday 12 machines went to American Basin and then over the passes back to Lake City. There will be work rides forthcoming.

Cowboy Cookouts: This second cookout will be held on Sunday 7/25 at Shaw Mesa. Stay on the main road for 2 miles and you will see the site. Cooking will start at 12:30. Bring chairs, meat for grilling, your drinks, and a side dish for pot luck. The next cookout will be in August.
